## **Monthly Overview**



Through our public engagement, both in-person and online we reached approximately 720 people in August 2025.



## Intelligence Summary



This month 47% of feedback was of a negative sentiment and 25% positive. A further 8% of stories shared provided a mixed perspective or was unclear, and 19% had a neutral or no sentiment.

The stories shared typically had themes of...




Quality of treatment

Of the stories shared, we heard the most about...






