
Monthly Overview

We have continued to attend local Community Lounges, including the PEGiS (Parent Engagement Group in Stoke) SEND (Special Education Needs and Disabilities) Community Lounge, we also joined PEGiS for their PEGiS in the Park events throughout July! Our team took part in another 'queue walk' at a The Bread and Butter Thing (TBBT) venue. As part of one of our priority projects, we visited Caudwell Children to learn more about what they have to offer. Lastly, we attended the Stoke-on-Trent City Council's Support Services Commissioning Development Event.

Through our public engagement, both in-person and online we reached approximately 950 people in July 2025.



Intelligence Summary



Negative sentiments remain to be most common with a 6% increase on negative feedback since June. There was a reduction in positive feedback by 5% and a total absence of any mixed or unclear feedback. This month we saw an increase of requests for advice and information leading to 28% of feedback being of a neutral or lacking a sentiment.

Follow-on treatment and continuity of care




