Quarterly Overview

As we have come to the end of our second quarter in 2025/26, we have decided to offer an insight into September along with providing a recap of this quarter.

Throughout July to September, we heard from a total of 93 people living in Stoke-on-Trent who were looking to share their stories or seeking information. We also engaged with approximately 650 people both online and in-person in September, leading to a quarterly total of 2300 people.


Each month, we've shared with you the key themes and top services that we've received feedback on. Using these findings, we have found that the top 3 services throughout this quarter are:

- GPs,
- · CAMHS,
- and dentists.

And the key themes of this quarter are:

- waiting times,
- waiting for appointments or treatment; waiting lists,
- and quality of treatment.

Intelligence Summary



In September, 56% of people contacted us about a negative experience. We saw a 25% decrease in positive stories shared with 0 positive experiences being shared. 11% of stories were of a mixed or had an unclear sentiment. The remaining 33% shared stories of a neutral sentiment or contacted us without sharng a story (i.e. information and/or advice).

The stories shared typically had themes of...




Top 3 Services
